### YOUR BACKUP CARE DETAILS:

- Up to 20 days/year
- Benefit year is July 1-June 30
- Tiered co-pay amounts valid through 10/31

### SUBSIDIZED RATES:

- In-center: \$10/day
- In-home: based on employee salary:
  - \$0-\$55,000 - \$3/hr
  - \$55,001-\$99,999: \$6/hr
  - \$100,000 and above: \$10/hr
