# MENTOR FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### WHAT IS THE TIME COMMITTMENT?

2 hours/month are expected to be dedicated to this program. Majority of participants indicate meeting with their counterpart 6-9 times within the 6-month period.

#### **DO I NEED MENTOR EXPERIENCE?**

No previous formal mentoring experience is needed. In your current role, it is very likely that you have informally mentored others without realizing it! A Mentor Orientation Workshop is provided to develop skills and ask questions.

### WHAT RESOURCES WILL BE AVAILABLE TO ME?

As part of the program, mentors are provided several resources such as mentor-specific training, University resource guide to aid in conversations, and access to Chronus software for scheduling and communication.

### HOW DO YOU MATCH ME WITH A MENTEE?

Based on mentee and mentor Chronus profile, field of work/study, and areas of interest, the Chronus software matches connections that best align. Harvard administrators review all matches to ensure connections are appropriate. In the 2024 cohort, 100% of mentor survey respondents indicated "satisfied or very satisfied" to their mentoring partner match.

### IS THIS PROGRAM DYNAMIC-WORK FRIENDLY?

Yes! All workshops are fully remote. Your 1-on-1 mentorship meetings can be remote or in-person, based on your dynamic work status and preferences.
